

Swansea MC is attracting an excellent field for the all new Hillclimb at Llys-Fran Country Park in Carmarthenshire on Sunday, over sixty entries already confirmed.

Cars included in that entry include Porsche Club Chairman Terry Davison, on home ground with his 911, Liskeards Jonathon Williams in his Carrera, Porsche preparation expert Josh Sadler in his 3.2 litre Carrera 911, Nick Wadhams Renault Alpine A110, and ten Westfield sportscars. Cooper 500 racing cars are also particularly well represented, as is the rallying brigade, with entries ranging from an early Volvo 122S to the latest Peugeot Rallye. "Libre" racing cars will also provide fast action, the Tim Daniels Mallock M24 and Elmers Phantom P84/94 expected to set the pace.

NEW SWANSEA MOTOR CLUB HILL CLIMB

Swansea Motor Club returns to the hill-climb scene in 1995, the club organisation such an event at a totally new venue in West Wales, the Llys-Y-Fran Reservoir and country Park hosting the 30th of July meeting.

The climb - the first hill climb in West Wales since the framed Lydstep events in the fifties - comes to fruition after negotiations

between Swansea MC and Officials of Hamdden, the Leisure arm of Dwr Cymru (Welsh Water), operators of the 200 acre site between Haverfordwest and Carmarthen and features a 820 yard climb through the park land around the 100 foot dam. 23 classes are catered for, including Diesel, Road cars, Modified Saloon and Sports, Historics, Vintage and Racing cars, Rallycars and

Kitcars, Disabled drivers, and Libre cars, with a maximum entry of 80 and an entry fee of \$60.

The event will be a prelude to the Pembrokeshire Country Fair at the venue on August 6th, Hamdden keen to develop the site into an all round leisure oriented venue in addition to providing the major water supply to West Wales.
